





WORLDS OF FUN WILL ADD TWO FAMILY ATTRACTIONS FOR ITS 25TH ANNIVERSARY SEASON

Kansas City, Mo. -- Worlds of Fun will celebrate its 25th anniversary season in 1997 with two great new family attractions. This Spring, the Berenstain Bears will be putting the finishing touches on their new home at Worlds of Fun, while the Forum Amphitheatre will prepare to add a customized laser light, sound and pyrotechnic show to its 1997 concert and entertainment lineup.

Berenstain Bear Country, a life-size setting taken from the pages of the best-selling Berenstain Bear children's books, will debut this Spring (date to be announced) at Worlds of Fun. Berenstain Bear Country will cover approximately one acre of land with play areas and interactive attractions for kids under 54" tall. Kids will be able to act out their favorite Berenstain Bear stories while Papa, Mama, Brother, and Sister Bear characters bring the storybook setting to life.

One of the biggest parts of Berenstain Bear Country will be the Bear Museum, equipped with a wide variety of activities to teach and challenge youngsters. Children will be able to create electricity, test gravity and centrifugal force with hands-on learning tools. The Bear Museum will also house the Computer Cave, with interactive computers, plus the popular Bear Library filled with copies of Berenstain Bear books for kids to read.

The Bear Family Tree House will welcome guests inside to explore the Berenstain Bear family home. Standing approximately 30 feet tall, the tree house will have three levels which guests can view from the inside of the first floor.

The Boys Club, from the story, "No Girls Allowed," will actually welcome girls and boys to try several games and activities including a periscope, tic-tac-toe and a log roll. The Dinosaur Pit, from the story "The Day of the Dinosaur," will feature a fossil digging area and a 6-foot-tall dinosaur skeleton.

Inspired by "The Spooky Old Tree" book, kids will be able to act out the popular story line "Up a ladder, through the floor, down a slide and out a door." The Spooky Old Tree in Bear Country will come complete with ladders and slides, plus claw-shaped limbs and glowing eyes.

In addition to the special story themed areas of Bear Country, several exciting and educational activities will be spread throughout this section of the park.

Worlds of Fun's Forum Amphitheatre will provide the perfect venue for another new attraction this summer. A customized laser show will combine laser lights, pyrotechnics and music into a spectacular show. A projection screen, measuring over 2,000 square feet, will be constructed above the stage at the Forum to display this collaboration of modern technology for guests of all ages.

"We are thrilled to be able to provide these exciting new attractions for Worlds of Fun's 25th anniversary season," said Daniel R. Keller, Vice President and General Manager of Worlds of Fun. "Berenstain Bear Country will appeal to kids and parents with its fun and educational elements, while the laser light show will entertain guests of all ages as well."

With these two new family attractions, Worlds of Fun will offer a Junior ticket priced at \$4.95 (plus tax) for kids four years old and over and up to 48" tall and a Junior Season Passport priced at \$30.95 (plus tax) for kids four years old and over and up to 48" tall at the time of processing. Children three and under will be admitted free. Worlds of Fun will open for its 25th anniversary season on April 12, 1997.

The Detonator

Worlds of Fun reached new heights of fun in 1996 with the world's first 200-foot, twin-tower ride. The Detonator dares riders to be shot 180 feet straight up, without warning, and then dropped back to earth after a weightless experience in the sky. Thrill seekers must try this gravity defying blast.

The Timber Wolf

Riders can challenge 4,320 feet of terrifying timber on one of the world's top ranked wooden roller coasters. The Timber Wolf speeds down a quick 95-foot drop before twisting and turning through two and a half minutes of screaming fun. This wooden beast has been consistently rated among the best, by coaster enthusiasts, since it was unleashed in 1989.

Berenstain Bear Country

The pages of the best-selling children's books come to life in Berenstain Bear Country. Kids' favorite Berenstain Bear stories are replicated in this entertaining and educational fantasyland of interactive activities. The Berenstain Bear family is right at home in this storybook setting where visitors, and bear hugs, are always welcome.

ABOUT CEDAR FAIR, L.P.

Cedar Fair, L.P. is a publicly traded, limited partnership that owns and operates four seasonal amusement park complexes in the United States including: Worlds of Fun and Oceans of Fun in Kansas City, Mo.; Cedar Point in Sandusky, Ohio; Valleyfair in Shakopee, Minn.; and Dorney Park & Wildwater Kingdom in Allentown, Pa.

Together, these four parks serve market areas totaling 75 million people. The company's reinvestment efforts and philosophy of offering quality family entertainment will be highlighted with \$32 million in capitol improvements for the 1997 operating season -- the largest amount ever invested. Since 1987, Cedar Fair, L.P. has reinvested more than \$190 million in its parks.

Improvements at Cedar Fair parks for 1997 include "Steel Force," one of the world's tallest and fastest roller coasters at Dorney Park & Wildwater Kingdom; Berenstain Bear Country, a children's activity area, and a laser/light show at Worlds of Fun; an expanded entrance plaza and food complex at Valleyfair; and a spinning thrill ride, a paddleboat ride and a food complex at Cedar Point. Soak City, a water park adjacent to Cedar Point will undergo a major expansion to include a 500,000-gallon wave pool, action slides, a family activity pool and an adult complex with a swim-up refreshment center.

Cedar Fair is listed on the New York Stock Exchange under the trading symbol "Fun."

Worlds of Fun and Oceans of Fun

The newest additions to Cedar Fair's portfolio, Kansas City's Worlds of Fun and Oceans of Fun, were acquired in 1995 for \$40 million.

Worlds of Fun is a family oriented amusement park facility patterned after the famous Jules Verne's tale, "Around the World in Eighty Days." Five themed continent areas: Americana, Africa, Europa, the Orient and Scandinavia, cover over 170 acres with major rides, live shows and various attractions, including the Timber Wolf, a world-class wooden roller coaster, the gravity defying Detonator, plus an outdoor amphitheatre showcasing national entertainers throughout the season.

Next door, Oceans of Fun makes up the Midwest's largest water park with over 60 acres of wet and wild adventures. A million-gallon wave pool, seven water slides, two special children's areas and an assortment of water sports and activities are featured in this tropically-themed water paradise.

Cedar Point

With 57 rides, including 12 roller coasters, Cedar Point is the largest amusement ride park in the world. The resort also offers two lakeside hotels, an RV campground, one of the largest marinas on the Great Lakes, a strip of natural white sand beach, children's activities, award winning landscaping, live stage shows and animal presentations. Combined with the adjacent Challenge Park, an entertainment complex that features the RipCord Skycoaster© thrill ride, a go-kart speedway and two miniature golf courses, and Soak City, one of the nation's largest water parks, Cedar Point is unmatched in its variety of world-class entertainment. Valleyfair

Valleyfair is an old fashioned fun park covering nearly 70 acres near the Minnesota River. Thrill seekers can challenge the steep drops and relentless speed of Wild Thing, one of the tallest and fastest coasters in the world, while others can enjoy the water park and amusement park favorites like the railroad, special kids areas and live entertainment. Dorney Park & Wildwater Kingdom

Dorney Park & Wildwater Kingdom is a 200-acre combination amusement/water park.
