Helpful Hints



ATMs UMB Bank ATMs are located at Worlds of Fun just outside the Main Entrance and near Vittle Griddle in the Americana section.



Credit Cards VISA, MasterCard, Discover Card, American Express, and most Debit Cards are accepted for park admission, at most merchandise locations, and at select restaurants throughout the park.



Cameras & Film Did you forget your camera? Get Kodak film and stillshot cameras at select gift shops.



Dress & Behavior In keeping with the family image of Worlds of Fun, we require guests to wear appropriate clothing while in the park. Profanity, illegal substances, and suggestive or offensive clothing are prohibited. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times. Laser pointer/pens are not permitted at Worlds of Fun. Weapons are never permitted on Worlds of Fun property. Use of cameras and/or cell phones are not permitted inside park restrooms.



Food & Beverage Options Concession areas are located throughout Worlds of Fun. Coolers, food or beverages may not be taken inside the park. Public picnic tables are located outside Worlds of Fun between parking lots E and F and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Worlds of Fun does not permit grilling, open flames or outside vendors to cater picnics on park property. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted outside the serving areas or in the picnic areas located by the parking lots.



Guest Relations & First Aid Guest Relations is located just outside the Main Entrance and is your complete source of information on Worlds of Fun. Worlds of Fun First Aid is located just inside the Main Entrance of Worlds of Fun.



Inclement Weather Most of our attractions and rides will remain in operation despite rain. We will re-open the closed rides as soon as possible. Certain rides will close for your protection when lightning or thunder is in the vicinity and will re-open as soon as possible. Worlds of Fun does not offer rain checks or refunds.



Line Jumping is not a Sporting Event To ensure that all guests have a fair opportunity to enjoy a ride as quickly as possible, line jumping is not allowed at Worlds of Fun. Line jumping, regardless of the reason, may lead to ejection from the park. **NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN.** Worlds of Fun defines line jumping as:
1. Cutting in front of other guests who are already in line; or
2. Saving a place for someone; or
3. Leaving a line, then attempting to re-enter at the same point.
Since this includes using the restroom or purchasing food or drink, we suggest you make all stops before you enter the line.



Lockers, Strollers, Wheelchairs & Scooters Storage lockers, baby strollers, wheelchairs and electric scooters are available on a first-come, first-served basis for a small rental fee near All Stars Grill. Worlds of Fun's strollers, wheelchairs, and electric scooters are prohibited from being taken outside of the park. Segway transporters are not permitted inside the park.



Lost People & Lost Articles We suggest you arrange a specific time and place for your group to meet prior to entering Worlds of Fun. Worlds of Fun does not offer personalized public paging. If a child becomes separated from your group, we suggest you contact one of the Worlds of Fun Security Personnel or go to the Guest Relations Office at the Main Entrance for assistance. Additionally, the Guest Relations Office can assist you with lost articles.



KidTrack KidTrack is available at Guest Relations at the Main Entrance. KidTrack wristbands help keep your kids safe. Just write your 10 digit cell phone number on your child's wristband. If you and your child become separated, the employee who finds your child will activate the KidTrack system, which calls your cell phone and reports where your child is being safely kept until you are reunited.



Re-Entering the Park If you plan to leave Worlds of Fun and return later in the day, ask the ticket taker at the re-admission turnstile to stamp your hand. Guests will not be allowed to reenter the park without a hand stamp. Be sure to keep your parking receipt if you take your car from the parking lot so you can re-enter without charge.



Rider Responsibility Law Missouri Statute RSMO 316.230 requires that riders obey all warnings and directions regarding all rides and behave in a manner that will not cause injury to themselves or contribute to the injury of others. Failure to comply may lead to ejection from the park and is a state misdemeanor.

Worlds of Fun's definition of a responsible person is one who meets all of the requirements to ride the ride himself, is 16 years of age or older and demonstrates appropriate observed behavior.



Rider Safety Guide/Guests With Disabilities This safety handbook provides Worlds of Fun guests with information regarding the ride regulations, guest services, park policies, and special services for guests with disabilities. The Rider Safety Guide is available at the Guest Relations Office. For more information, pick up a Rider Safety Guide at the Guest Relations Office located at the Main Entrance.



Rider Swap If you have small children and want to ride some of the rides that have a minimum height requirement but have no provisions for child care while you do, one responsible person may wait with the child on the midway near the exit while the rest of the party enters the line. The party waiting should notify the ride ambassador that the group is taking part in Rider Swap. When the party in line has ridden and exited, the person who waited with the child may ride, entering the ride through the exit. Accommodations can also be made for groups with a disabled rider.



No Smoking For the comfort of our guests, smoking is not permitted while riding or standing in line for rides or in any children's area. Additionally, smoking is not permitted at indoor restaurants, theatres, gift shops, and arcades.

Rider Height Requirements

For the safety of all park guests, all rides have rider height requirements based on the manufacturer's recommendations. Other appropriate safety requirements may also apply. The ride height requirements are listed below and are posted at the ride unit.

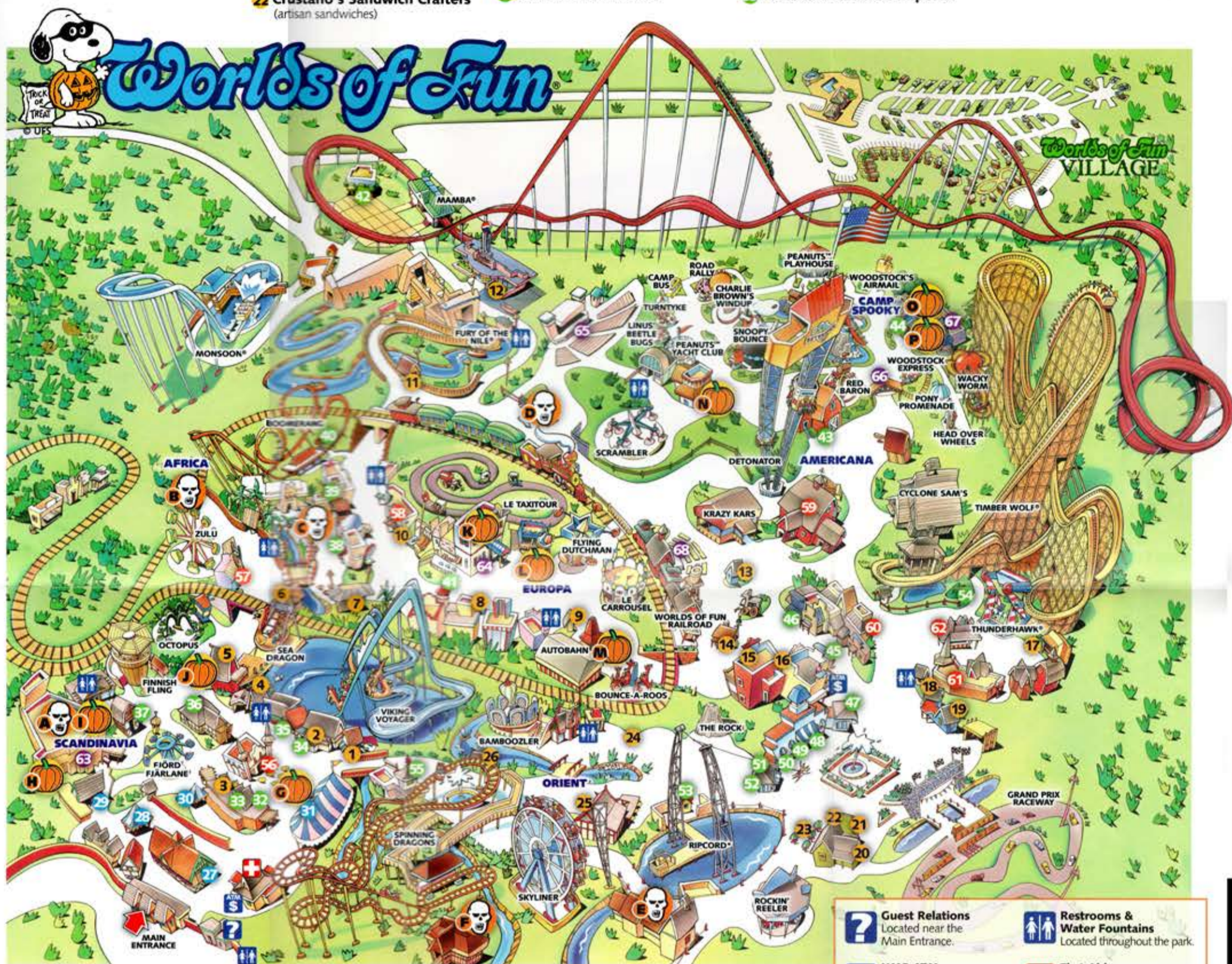
