Helpful Hints



ATMs UMB Bank ATMs are located at Worlds of Fun just outside the Main Entrance and near Vittle Griddle in the Americana section.



Credit Cards VISA, MasterCard, Discover Card, American Express, and most Debit Cards are accepted for park admission, at most merchandise locations, and at select restaurants throughout the park.



Cameras & Film Kodak one-time use cameras and film are available at select gift shops.



Dress & Behavior Admission is refused to guests in costume, masks, or full-face make-up. Worlds of Fun is a family park. We require guests to wear appropriate clothing while visiting. Clothing with profanity, reference to illegal substances, and/or suggestive or offensive messages is prohibited. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times. Weapons are never permitted on Worlds of Fun property. Use of cameras and/or cell phones is not permitted inside restrooms.



Food & Beverage Options Concession areas are located throughout Worlds of Fun. Coolers, food or beverages may not be taken inside the park. Public picnic tables are available on a first-come, first-served basis and are located outside Worlds of Fun between parking lots D and F. Grilling, open flames, and outside caterers are not permitted. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted outside serving areas inside the park, or in any picnic or parking area on Worlds of Fun property.



Guest Relations & First Aid Visit Guest Relations at the Worlds of Fun Main Entrance for more information during your visit. The Worlds of Fun First Aid station is located just inside the Main Entrance.



Attraction Availability Limited ride availability and Camp Spooky closed Friday nights. Other rides may close due to HalloWeekends activities. Most of our rides and attractions remain in operation despite rain. For your safety, certain rides and attractions may be closed due to rain, lightning, high winds, extreme temperatures, maintenance, and other reasons. We re-open closed rides and attractions as soon as possible. When a ride is closed, we suggest enjoying other attractions and checking back later. No rain checks or refunds.



Line Jumping is not a Sporting Event To ensure that all guests have a fair opportunity to enjoy a ride or attraction as quickly as possible, line jumping is not allowed at Worlds of Fun. Line jumping, regardless of the reason, may lead to ejection from the park. **NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN.** Worlds of Fun defines line jumping as:

1. Cutting in front of other guests who are already in line; or
 2. Saving a place for someone; or
 3. Leaving a line, then attempting to re-enter at the same point.
- Since this includes using the restroom or purchasing food or drink, we suggest you make all stops before you enter the line.



Lockers, Strollers, Wheelchairs & Scooters Lockers, strollers, wheelchairs, and electric scooters are available for rent on a first-come, first-served basis at Locker & Stroller Rental just inside the Worlds of Fun Main Entrance. Worlds of Fun's strollers, wheelchairs, and electric scooters may not be taken outside of the park gates or into the parking areas. Segway transporters are not permitted inside the park.



Lost People & Lost Articles We suggest you arrange a specific time and place for your group to meet prior to entering Worlds of Fun. Worlds of Fun does not offer personalized public paging. If a child becomes separated from your group, we suggest you contact one of the Worlds of Fun Security Rangers throughout the park, or go to Guest Relations at the Main Entrance for assistance. Guest Relations is also the place to go to report lost articles.



KidTrack KidTrack is available at Guest Relations at the Main Entrance. KidTrack wristbands help keep your kids safe. Just write your 10-digit cell phone number on your child's wristband. If you and your child become separated, the employee who finds your child will activate the KidTrack system, which calls your cell phone and reports where your child is being safely kept until you are reunited.



Re-Entering the Park If you plan to leave Worlds of Fun and return later in the day, ask the ticket taker at the re-admission turnstile to stamp your hand. Guests will not be allowed to re-enter the park without a hand stamp. Be sure to keep your parking receipt if you take your car from the parking lot so you can re-enter without charge. Vehicles left overnight may be towed at owner's expense.



Rider Responsibility Law Missouri Statute RSMO 316.230 requires that riders obey all warnings and directions regarding all rides and behave in a manner that will not cause injury to themselves or contribute to the injury of others. Failure to comply may lead to ejection from the park and is a state misdemeanor.

Worlds of Fun's definition of a responsible person is one who meets all of the requirements to ride the ride themselves, is 16 years of age or older and demonstrates appropriate observed behavior.



Rider Safety Guide/Guests With Disabilities The Rider Safety Guide is a safety handbook that provides Worlds of Fun guests with information regarding rider requirements, guest services, park policies, and special services for guests with disabilities. The Rider Safety Guide is available at the Guest Relations Office at the Main Entrance.



Rider Swap If you wish to ride some of the height-restricted rides but have guests in your party who cannot be left alone (small children, guests with disabilities, etc.), one responsible person may wait with the non-riding guests on the midway near the ride exit while the other guests in the party enter the line. The party waiting in line should notify the ride ambassador that the group is participating in Rider Swap. When the rest of the party in line has ridden and exited, the person who waited with the non-riding guests may enter through the exit and ride with one other rider who meets all rider requirements for that ride.



No Smoking For the comfort of our guests, smoking is not permitted while riding, standing in line for rides, in any children's area, or while inside indoor restaurants, theatres, gift shops, and arcades.

Rider Height Requirements

For the safety of all park guests, all rides have rider height requirements based on the manufacturer's recommendations. Other appropriate safety requirements may also apply. The ride height requirements are listed below and are posted at the ride unit.
